God Wants to Use You Right Where You Are

Have you ever wanted to make a difference for Christ but felt so ordinary? Maybe you've had this nagging sense that the world's problems are too big and what you have to offer is too small. Our lives have an extraordinary impact! God uses many people in the Bible to show us. In Judges 3, God tells us about Shamgar, an ordinary person, in an ordinary place, doing an ordinary job. It wasn't anything external that made him do anything extraordinary, but it was his internal drive to do the right thing and obey God right where he was.

The same is for us. If we obey God in the midst of our ordinary lives, extraordinary impact is always possible. Many times, we can feel like the wrong person for the job we are doing. Our background and occupation may hinder us as we can label ourselves as an unlikely candidate for God's mighty work.

If you long to live a life that has extraordinary impact:

Offer your willingness to him -Even if you feel small and unlikely- You are someone God can use- you don't disqualify!

Use what God has given you- God has given us gifts, talents, ability. All you need to do is sharpen them. Choose to believe God can use anything you humbly offer Him.

Stay true to who God created you to be- God is not asking you to be anyone other than who He designed you to be. No matter who you are, watch with humble amazement as God uses your willing, obedient, ordinary life to accomplish extraordinary things in His name.

Lord, thank you for reminding us that You can use anyone and everyone. We are willing to offer all that we have, and we choose to believe that we are enough to be used by you!
